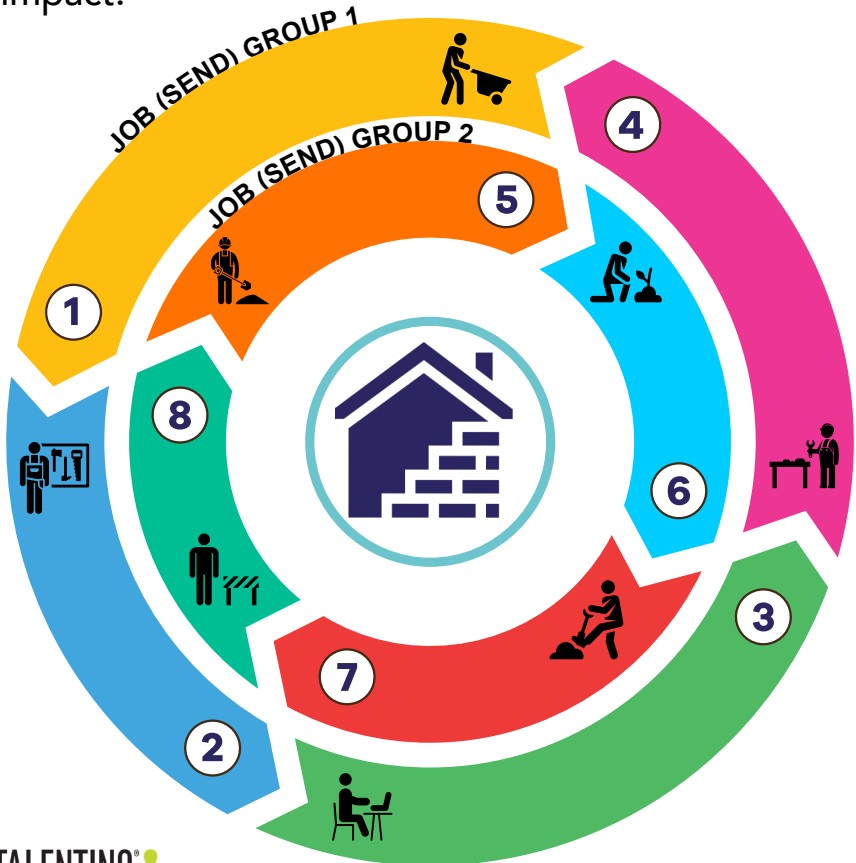

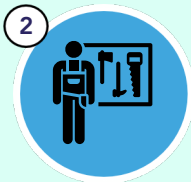
Construction Site Helper

They help cleanup, organise tools, and support skilled workers.



Annual Salary

£15,000 - £24,000



Tool Room Assistant

They help sort materials, store tools, and manage inventory.



Annual Salary

£14,000 - £23,000



Office Worker

They help file documents, photocopying, data entry, and other construction-related admin tasks.



Annual Salary

£14,000 - £28,000



Maintenance Worker

They help maintain site cleanliness, perform repairs, and aid with maintenance tasks.



Annual Salary

£18,500 - £25,000

JOB GROUP 2

do require at least Level 2 qualifications / GCSEs and can lead onto a Apprenticeships, University, College, Employment or Enterprise



General Labourer

They help with tasks like carrying materials, digging, and assisting with construction activities.



Annual Salary

£17,000 - £32,000



Gardening Assistant

They help grow and look after plants in parks, gardens and other green spaces.



Annual Salary

£19,500 - £26,000



Ground Worker

They help maintain site landscaping: mowing, planting, and ensuring grounds are clean and safe.



Annual Salary

£17,000 - £32,000



Traffic Controller

They help traffic on construction sites for safety, setting up cones and signage.



Annual Salary

£23,500 - £46,000
