





From roles in filming to various aspects of graphic design, the opportunities are diverse and exciting.



The CEC has adopted Talentino's #SameAndDifferent model, a national SEND school career framework designed to deliver effective career activities for young people with SEND. Developed from Talentino's work in schools, this concept enhances early career development and encourages employers to support the progression of individuals with SEND.



JOB GROUP 1

don't require Level 2 Qualifications / GCSEs but can lead to supported employment, Supported Internships, Inclusive Apprenticeships, supported Enterprise, T-Levels, Traineeships and FE College.



Assistant Editor

They help production teams organise footage, log data, and perform basic editing tasks.





Wardrobe Assistant

They help to make, find and look after clothes and costumes used in theatre, film and TV productions.
