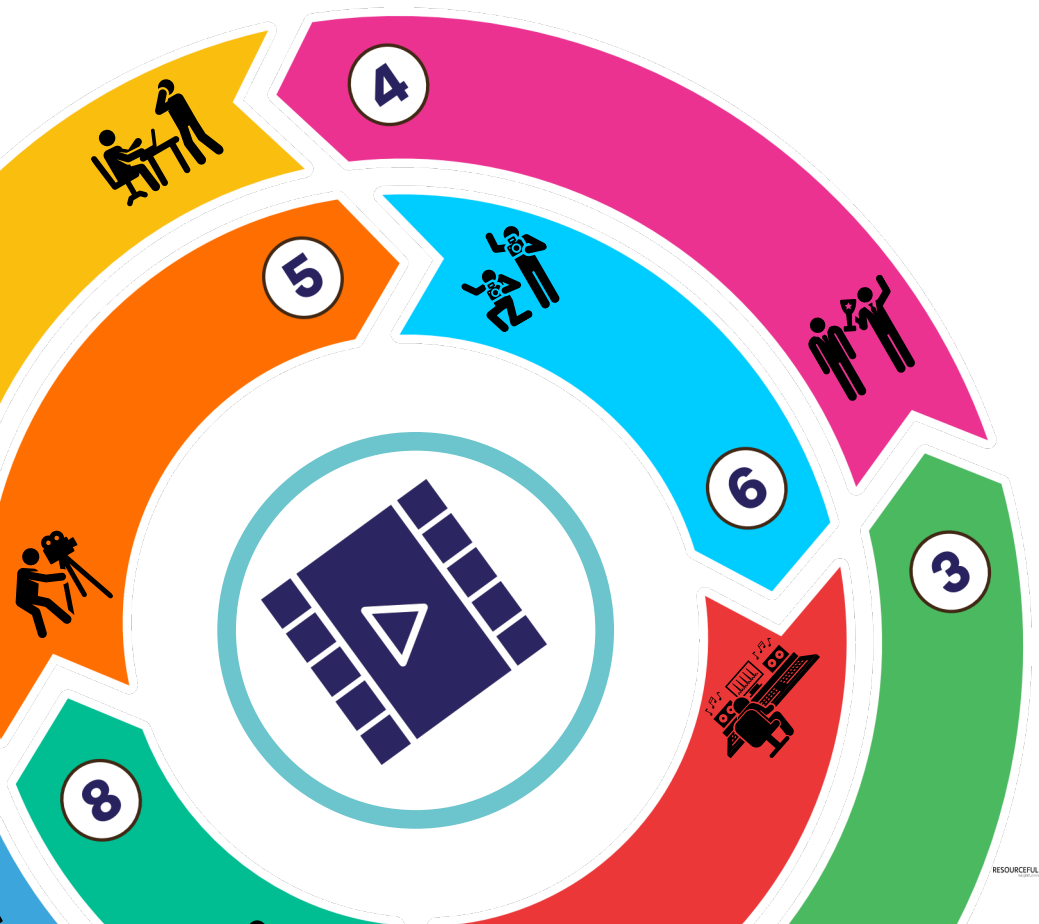

This guide is here to help you explore different job opportunities, understand how your skills can be applied in Creative, Media & Film, and discover the pathways that can lead you to a fulfilling career.



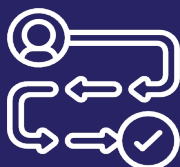
**Basic LMI:** Learn about Creative, Media & Film jobs, how many people are employed and the companies you could work for. This will give you a broad understanding of the job market.

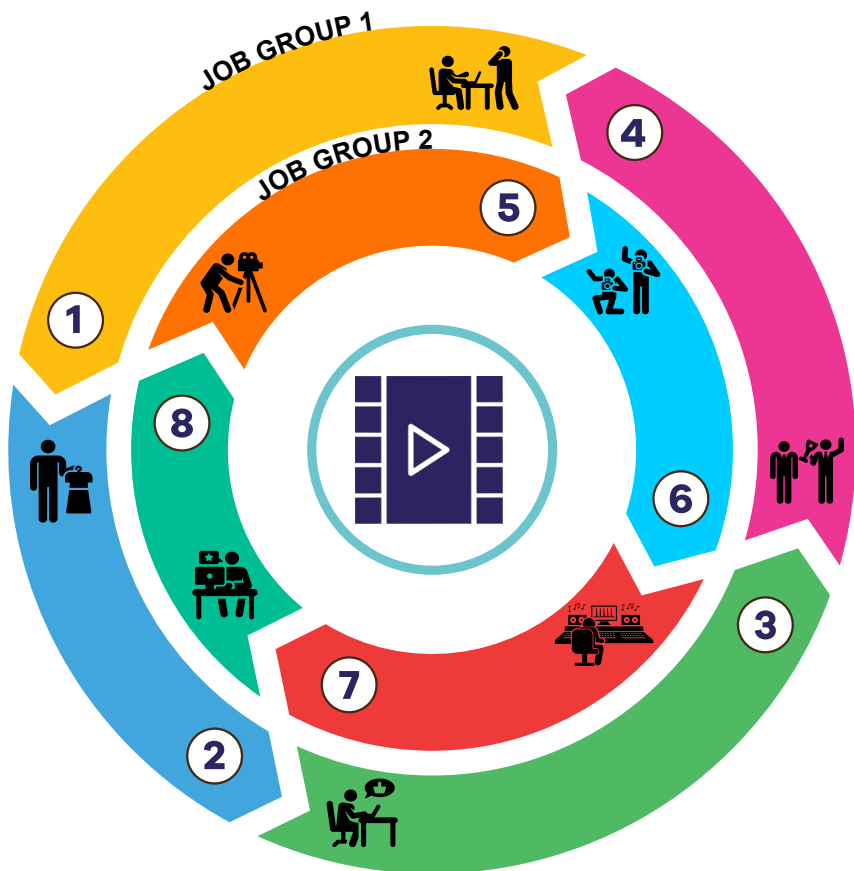

The CEC has adopted Talentino's #SameAndDifferent model, a national SEND school career framework designed to deliver effective career activities for young people with SEND. Developed from Talentino's work in schools, this concept enhances early career development and encourages employers to support the progression of individuals with SEND.
