This guide is here to help you explore different job opportunities, understand how your skills can be applied in Green Skilled jobs, and discover the pathways that can lead you to a fulfilling career.



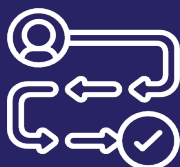
Basic LMI: Learn about green jobs, how many people are employed and the companies you could work for. This will give you a broad understanding of the job market.

Developed from Talentino's work in schools, this concept enhances early career development and encourages employers to support the progression of individuals with SEND.




JOB GROUP 1

don't require Level 2 Qualifications / GCSEs but can lead to supported employment, Supported Internships, Inclusive Apprenticeships, supported Enterprise, T-Levels, Traineeships and FE College.



Landscaping Assistant

They help maintain gardens, parks, or outdoor spaces by planting, weeding, mowing lawns, and pruning plants.

 Annual Salary
£20,000 - £26,000



Greenhouse Assistant

They help with plant care, watering, and maintaining greenhouse operations.

 Annual Salary
£19,000 - £25,000



Agriculture Assistant

They help feed, clean, and care for animals, ensuring they stay healthy and happy.

 Annual Salary
£18,000 - £25,500



Recycling Operative

Help sort and process recyclable materials such as paper, plastics, and metals in recycling facilities.

 Annual Salary
£13,000 - £24,000

JOB GROUP 2

do require at least Level 2 qualifications / GCSEs and can lead onto a Apprenticeships, University, College, Employment or Enterprise



Electronics Technician

They help design, build and maintain electronics systems and components.

 Annual Salary
£21,000 - £37,000



Forest Worker

The help plant, manage and harvest trees and care for the environment in forests and woodland.

 Annual Salary
£19,000 - £30,000



Wind Turbine Technician

They help maintain and repair wind farm turbines on land and at sea.

 Annual Salary
£25,000 - £47,000



Drone Operator

They remotely operate aircraft used in work like surveying, film making and aerial photography.

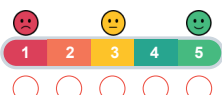


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
